Roy Thelen, DeWitt Area Emergency Services Authority – Riley had 7 runs for the month of June. The Sheldon barn burn is scheduled for July 16th. The authority approved switches for the Riley and Olive stations for generator power. The end of the fiscal year has passed, reports will be available next month. The authority is in good financial health, next year they would like to pay off the heavy rescue truck and will be debt free. The authority is looking at purchasing a new vehicle that could eventually be transitioned into a grass rig.

Randy Whitney, Riley Township Land Planning Committee- there is nothing new to report on the maps for the Land Planning Committee.

Supervisor Potts shared information on the present zoning for Schneider's Concrete on Price Road in the township. Documentation was located to validate that the property had previously been rezoned.

OLD BUSINESS:
